The idea behind this section of the prayer journal is so that one day, you can present this prayer journal to her as a legacy gift.

Photo Gallery

In this section, add a few photos of your daughter. You can even decorate the page as you would a scrapbook. Each time you pull out your prayer journal to pray for your daughter, you will be reminded of her beautiful smile!

Prayer Requests by Category

On this page, you can write down specific prayer requests you have for your daughter according to the following categories: her faith, relationships, emotional wellness, mental wellness, physical health, and work/education. There is even a section marked "other" where you can add your own categories. As you work your way through the prayer journal, you can always go back to those prayer requests you have written down.

Prayer Pages



A Prayer for her Heart


Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it. Proverbs 4:23
