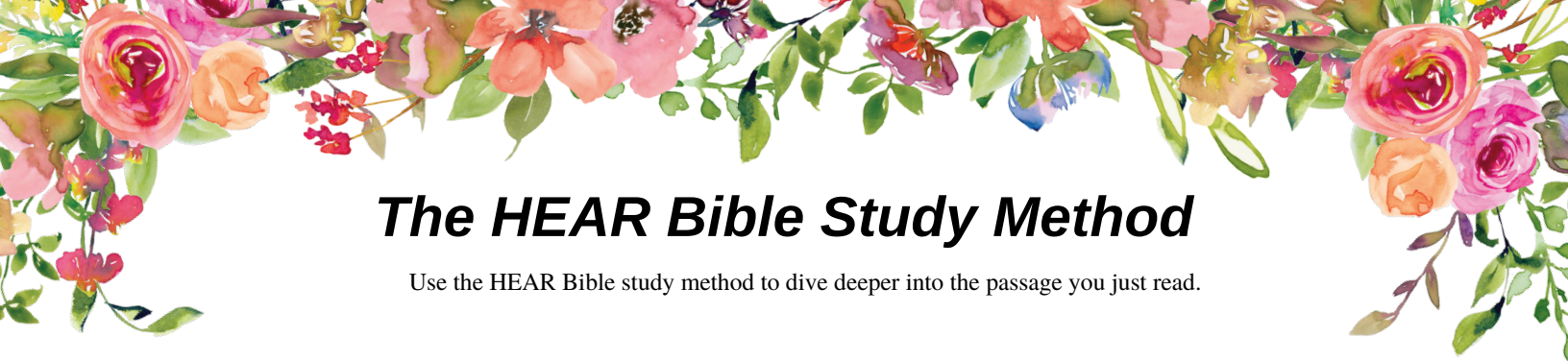

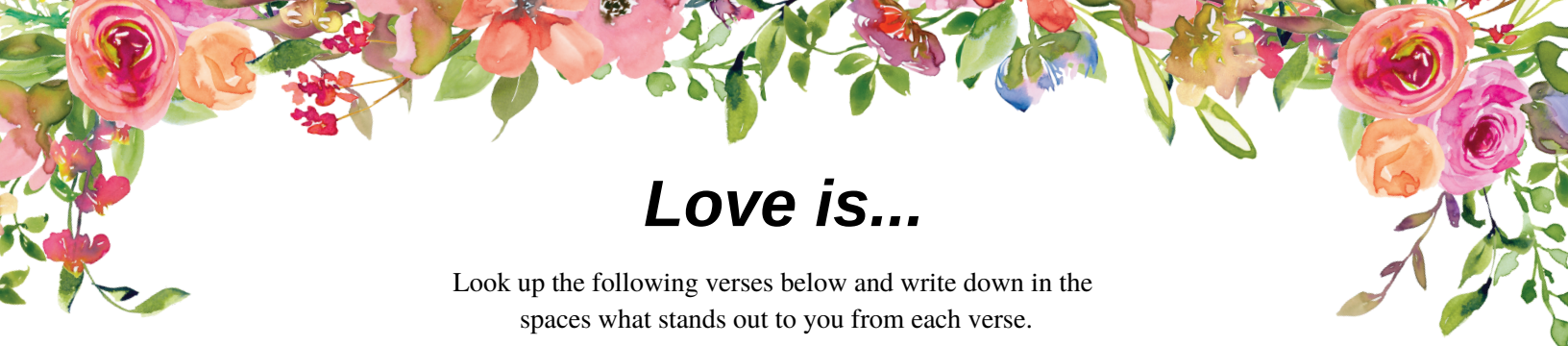

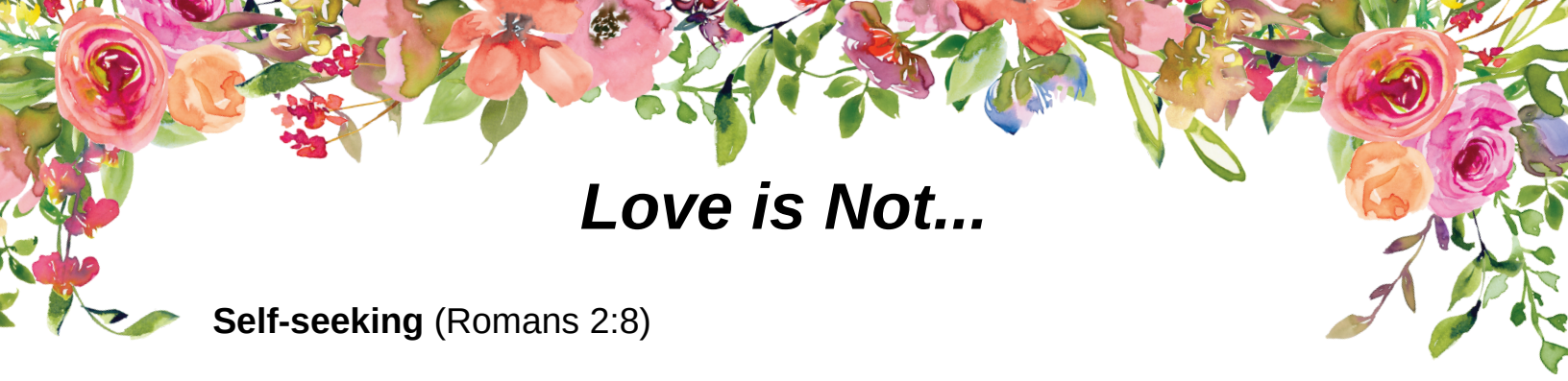

another. 12 No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God

lives in us and his love is made complete in us.

13 This is how we know that we live in him and he in us: He has given us

of his Spirit. 14 And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent his

has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in

love. 19 We love because he first loved us. 20 Whoever claims to love

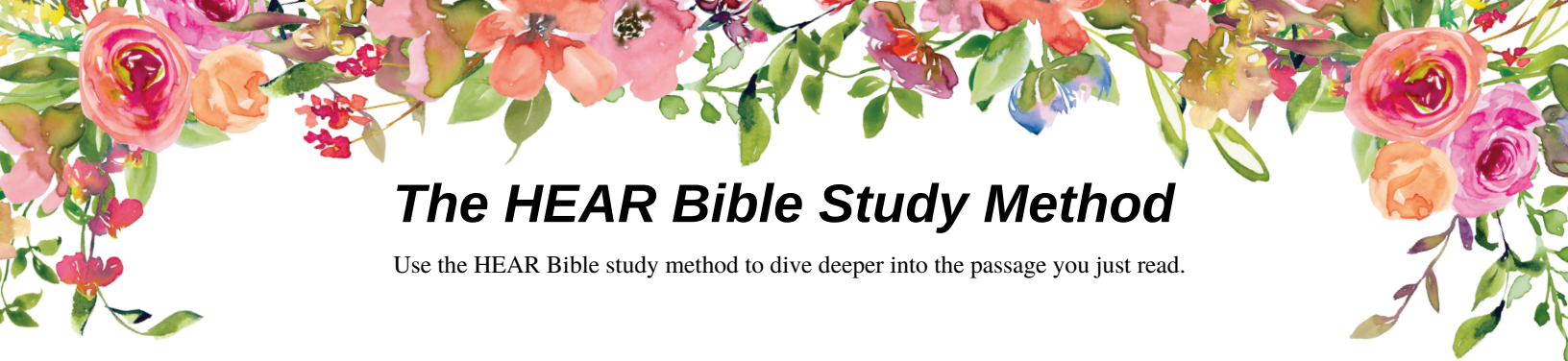
God yet hates a brother or sister is a liar. For whoever does not love their

brother and sister, whom they have seen, cannot love God, whom they

have not seen. 21 And he has given us this command: Anyone who loves

God must also love their brother and sister.
